



Participant Guidelines: How to know if your provider is ethical?

1. Ask if the provider has a code of ethics.
2. Ask for names of references, other people who receive or have received services from this provider.
3. The provider doesn't make promises about your services, friends, things you may get, etc.
4. The provider doesn't say negative things about other providers you may be considering.
5. The provider respects your right to make your own choices.
6. The provider respects that you can make your own decision and follows your wishes.
7. The provider does not share information about you to others unless you approve it.
8. The provider does everything they can to assure your health and safety.
9. The provider helps you be a part of the community and to participate in the activities of your choice.
10. The provider is careful to manage your service money, as well as your personal money, responsibly.
