



Provider Guidelines: Assuring that WyoSTEP, Inc. is adhering to professional and provider ethical standards.

1. WyoSTEP's supports and services are a public trust that requires integrity, compassion, and respect for individual differences and choices.
2. WyoSTEP's supports and services are designed to meet the needs of the individual with emphasis on promoting choice, self-determination, inclusion, growth, and development.
3. WyoSTEP respects the privacy of participants and protects the rights of confidentiality.
4. WyoSTEP gives preference to professional responsibility over corporate interests.
5. WyoSTEP advocates for standards that promote outcomes of quality for people.
6. WyoSTEP provides supports and services that can best assure the health and safety of participants.
7. WyoSTEP advocates for protection of the individual and the community against unethical and/or illegal practices or actions by other individuals or organizations engaged in providing supports.
8. WyoSTEP does not discriminate because of race, color, religion, age, sex, sexual orientation, disability, or national ancestry, and shall work to eliminate or prevent such discrimination in providing supports.
9. WyoSTEP promotes inclusion and equitable treatment of all people including participants, employees, friends, families, and the public.
10. WyoSTEP is a responsible steward for public and private funds.
11. WyoSTEP does not solicit participants who are currently receiving services from another provider.
12. WyoSTEP does not make promises or offer incentives to participants or others to recruit participants or employees.
